

Summer Stage School FAQ

How do I enrol?

You can enrol via the school website. St George's students will have priority until 31st March and anyone applying before that date will have their place confirmed by April 4th.

How much does it cost?

The cost is 400 euro for the 5 day learning programme plus the performance (with props and costumes). Each student will also receive a t-shirt, actor's book and recording of songs. Each student will have a pizza dinner on the evening of the show.

When is it?

Week one runs from Monday 13th to Friday 17th July from 9-4pm each day. The final performance will be on Friday 17th July at 6-7.30pm.

Week two runs from Monday 17th to Friday 21st August from 9-4pm each day. The final performance will be on Friday 21st August at 6-7.30pm.

Can I book early drop-off/late pick-up?

No. This facility is not on offer. Please do not request it. Late pick-ups are charged at 50 euro unless there are extenuating circumstances.

How about lunch?

Children should bring a packed lunch, water bottle and snack each day. Or you may like to use a lunch delivery service such as lunchtime.lu or grouplunch.lu to be delivered to school (in the name of the student please). On performance night, we will provide a pizza dinner before the show.

Who can join?

We offer priority to St George's students until March 31st. We will then offer places to the wider English-language community in Luxembourg.

Is this programme suitable for everyone?

While we are happy to accept anyone interested in the course, we would like to stress that this programme is recommended for students **with a clear interest** in performing arts (acting, singing, dancing and art). It is NOT recommended for students who do not like performance. Please note, all classes will take place in English. Students should be fluent in English.

Do children have to do any work?

Students will be expected to learn from memory lyrics and script words over the course of the week. We will give students the materials ahead of time to enable them to familiarise themselves with the songs and storylines.
